- Measure sales by time frame, location, product line, department, and salesperson

- View on a map the location of fields from blend tickets or Ship To locations for customers with open bookings to geographically analyze use of agronomy resources
- Monitor scale ticket activity such as grain scale turnaround time for grain unloading, purchase contracts, and grain ranking
- Analyze payments on customer accounts by the number of days since the last payment
- Analyze a customer's accounts receivable history including credits, invoices, payments, splits, and balances
- View energy fuel delivery and tank information and view your customers' energy fuel tanks on a map to potentially reevaluate driver assignments
- View top customers, products or sellers
- Identify high balances, past dues, and regular payments to determine collection necessity
- Assist customers to understand payments that utilized Unapplied Cash balances
