This role involves working closely with students identified as Gifted & Talented and with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) ensuring they receive the support needed to thrive both academically and socially within our school environment.

The main focus of your role will be to provide suitable activities, experiences, support and challenge for students identified as Gifted & Talented. As part of our Inclusion team , you will also be required to support some students with SEND requirements, particularly in secondary school.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Duties:

- provide tailored support to both SEND and Gifted & Talented students in classroom settings and on a one-to-one basis.
- Assist in the implementation of Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for SEND students
- Assist with identification of G&T Students
- Prepare advanced learning plans and activities for Gifted & Talented students.
- Monitor and track the progress of students, providing feedback and suggesting adjustments to learning strategies as required.

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- Utilize and adapt resources to meet the varying needs of SEND and Gifted & Talented students.
- Participate in training sessions and professional development opportunities related to SEND and gifted education.
- Assist in organizing and supervising school activities that promote inclusion and enriched learning experiences.
- Keep up to date with relevant developments in the area of G&T , stretch & challenge to ensure these are reflected in our provision and that best practice is promoted
- Maintain good order and discipline amongst students, in accordance with the school's behaviour policy;
