



CAP Tulsa Early Childhood Programs Required Documents Checklist

In order to complete your application interview, you will need to provide the required documents listed below. **If we have not received all of the required documents, your application interview will not be completed.**

1. Required Documents for **ALL children under the age of 5**

<input type="checkbox"/> Current Shot Record	Provide current immunization (shot) records
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Birth	Provide one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Issued Birth Certificate (<i>required for 4 year-old</i>) • Hospital Birth Record • Passport (U.S. or Foreign) • Refugee Documentation
<input type="checkbox"/> Well Child Physical	Provide the most up-to-date physical exam
<input type="checkbox"/> Health Insurance Card	Provide a copy of your child's health insurance card, if applicable
<input type="checkbox"/> IEP or IFSP	Provide a copy of the IEP/IFSP, if your child has a documented disabled or requires special assistance

2. Required Documents for **your family**

<input type="checkbox"/> Current Photo ID of the Parent or Legal Guardian	Provide one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State or government issued driver's license or photo ID • Resident ID card • Work permit • Current High School ID
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Current Address	Provide one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current lease or mortgage agreement/statement • Utility bill dated within the last 2 months • Letter from a shelter • Proof of Address with Host Letter: <i>if you are currently living with someone and you don't have a proof of address in your name, provide a proof of address with the name of the person who is hosting you and a signed letter from your host stating that you are currently living with them.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Income You must provide documentation of ALL income your family received in the previous 12 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current <u>Federal</u> Income Tax Return (<i>State Tax Return Not Accepted</i>) Other acceptable proofs of family income received in the previous 12 months: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • W-2 from all employers for the previous year • Pay stubs: (must include employee name, date of pay, and income before deductions) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Current Employer(s): All pay stubs from the previous 30 days ◦ Previous Employer(s): Final pay stub from all previous employers in last 12 months • Social Security (SSA) award letter • Employer Letter: Statement from all current and previous employers that includes employee name, dates of employment, pay rate, pay frequency and employer contact information • Child Support Documentation: Official court-order or if voluntary a letter from the parent providing support • Financial Aid Award Letter (college student)
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Public Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SNAP Award Letter/Documentation (<i>EBT Card is Not Accepted</i>) • SSI Award Letter/Documentation • TANF Award Letter/Documentation • OKDHS or Tribal Childcare Assistance Award Letter/Documentation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ <i>Preference is given to families who receive childcare assistance</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Foster Placement or Custody/Guardianship Documentation	If the child you are applying for is a foster child or if you have a legal custody/guardianship arrangement , please provide the official signed and dated legal documents for all children under the age of 5.
