

Celebrating 20 years of excellence, the Critical Language Scholarship (CLS) Program is a funded immersive summer study abroad opportunity for American college and university students to learn languages of strategic importance to the United States' national security and economic prosperity.

WHY CHOOSE CLS?

Participants receive the equivalent of one year of college-level language study in just eight weeks through intensive language instruction and cultural activities that reinforce language learning and intercultural competence. The CLS Program offers:

- Intensive coursework led by native speakers
- Homestays or dormitory living with local students
- Weekly conversations with language partners

Since its inception in 2006, the CLS Program has supported over 10,000 participants from all 50 U.S. states, equipping them with language and intercultural skills that set them apart in today's global job market.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Applicants must be:

- U.S. citizen or national
- At least 18 years old by May 15, 2026
- Enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate-level degree-granting program at a U.S. college or university at the time of application

Preference will be given to veterans of the U.S. armed forces. Automatic semifinalist status will be given to alumni of the 2025 CLS Spark virtual initiative who maintain eligibility and apply to continue studying their Spark language.

HOW IS THE PROGRAM STRUCTURED?

- 8 weeks of immersive language and cultural learning
- 18 hours per week of small-group instruction led by expert teachers
- Weekly one-on-one sessions with instructors
- Regular conversation practice with local language partners
- Hands-on cultural activities and excursions to historic sites
- Comprehensive support from dedicated program staff

The CLS Program is part of a U.S. government effort to increase the number of Americans studying and mastering critical foreign languages. CLS alumni use their skills to advance U.S. interests, foster innovation, and address global challenges in fields such as technology, medicine, and national defense. According to surveyed alumni who are currently employed:



96% say that the skills gained through CLS made them more competitive in the job market.
