# **22 Bishopsgate**London

There's iconic buildings and then there's 22 Bishopsgate; the newest, brightest addition to London's skyline.

Hailed as the 'Vertical Village', 22 Bishopsgate is a 62-storey landmark providing more than 1.2 million sq ft of office space, as well as vast social areas, a market and the very best views of the Capital from a free viewing gallery.

A true 'building of the future' 22 is focused on providing a location which acts as a hub that caters to every need for a diverse community. From work to play, there will be a wealth of amenities to suit every taste - think gym, meeting spots, tasty food options, an incredible bike park, co-working, and even a club.

Our role within this project was to provide the connection design, fabrication and construction of approximately 17,000 tonnes of steelwork. This was delivered by a shared pit lane on Bishopsgate and the adjacent street - Undershaft, between the site and 122 Leadenhall.

This is an exciting and ambitious development.

Superelevations, axial shortening and complex geometrical dilemmas posed by the double-height outrigger truss floor levels did pose some challenges, but with some considered technical designs, we were able to make sure everything from the design studies and reports were met.
