

Severfield Group Quality Policy Statement of Intent

The Board of Directors of Severfield plc (the Group) require the Directors of the Divisions to implement and maintain the Group Quality Management System to apply this Statement of Intent.

The Group Divisions in this statement include Severfield Commercial and Industrial, Severfield Nuclear and Infrastructure and Severfield Products and Processing.

The Group recognise that the needs of its employees, others for whom the Company provides employment, and the prosperity of the Company, are inextricably linked. A principal aim of the Group Board of Directors is for each Division's directors, managers, and employees to behave ethically and responsibly in the fields of Quality Management, and to constantly strive to meet and exceed Customer requirements. This Policy runs alongside the Group Safety, Health and Environmental, Sustainability, Nuclear Safety, and Information Security Policies.

Group Quality, in conjunction with each Division, will act to:

- Maintain a Group Quality Management System (QMS) adopted by all Divisions. The Group QMS will comply to the requirements of, but not limited to, any applicable Statutory and Regulatory requirements, ISO 9001, ISO 3834 (applicable parts), BS EN 1090 (applicable parts) and Sector Schemes, such as NHSS 19A, NHSS 20 and Fit for Nuclear (F4N).
- Support the Quality and Production Teams within the Divisions to re-invigorate root cause analysis, problem solving and permanent corrective actions within factory operations as part of an on-going drive for continual improvement.
- Ensure such training and resources required to deliver customer and company quality requirements are made available.

Each Division, in recognising that no policy can be effective without the full co-operation of its employees and sub-contractors, reminds them that all employees and sub-contractors are required to co-operate with the implementation of this Quality Policy Statement of Intent.

Each Division's Quality Team, with support from Group Quality, will provide competent technical advice on Quality matters. This provision does not relieve any individual of their own, stated, responsibilities.
