



Curriculum Plan – Year 11 IGCSE Art

Please find below a detailed outline of the curriculum covered in Art through Year 2021/22 in Year 11. Students will work through two components; coursework and an external examination. They will explore a range of artists, techniques and styles to develop their practical skills in accordance with the Cambridge IGCSE Assessment Objectives, whilst having greater independence and ownership of their work.

	<p>Component 1: Coursework (50% of overall grade)</p> <p>Students will select a title for an independent project, based on an area of personal interest.</p> <p>They will work in accordance with the Assessment Objectives and produce observational studies, artist research and developmental studies before producing a final piece.</p> <p>The final piece will be started and completed within allocated time under exam conditions for the Mock. This will prepare students for the External Exam, where they will have 8 hours to produce their final piece under supervision.</p>	<p>Component 2: External Exam (50% of overall grade)</p> <p>Students will be provided with a question paper that has a selection of titles. They will choose one to respond to.</p> <p>They will work in accordance with the Assessment Objectives and produce observational studies, artist research and developmental studies before producing a final piece.</p> <p>The final piece is produced in 8 hours of supervised time in exam conditions, and will conclude the program of study.</p> <p>Both components will be sent to Cambridge for assessment.</p>
