



## Curriculum Plan – Year 12 AS Level Art

Please find below a detailed outline of the curriculum covered in Art through Year 2021/22 in Year 12. Students will work through two components; coursework and an external examination. They will explore a range of artists, techniques and styles to develop their practical skills in accordance with the Cambridge AS Level Assessment Objectives, whilst having greater independence and ownership of their work.

	<p><b>Component 1: Coursework (50% of overall AS grade, 25% of A Level)</b></p> <p>Project1: Students will first work through a teacher-led project, developing skills in written and practical work whilst gaining a better understanding of the expectations/assessment objectives.</p> <p>Project 2: Students will select a title for an independent project, based on an area of personal interest.</p> <p>They will work in accordance with the Assessment Objectives and produce observational studies, artist research and developmental studies before producing a final piece.</p> <p>The final piece will be started and completed within allocated time under exam conditions for the Mock. This will prepare students for the External Exam, where they will have 15 hours to produce their final piece under supervision.</p>	<p><b>Component 2: External Exam (50% of overall AS grade, 25% of A Level)</b></p> <p>Students will be provided with a question paper that has a selection of titles. They will choose one to respond to.</p> <p>They will work in accordance with the Assessment Objectives and produce observational studies, artist research and developmental studies before producing a final piece.</p> <p>The final piece is produced in 15 hours of supervised time in exam conditions, and will conclude the program of study.</p> <p>Both components will be sent to Cambridge for assessment.</p>
