<p>Ukulele.</p> <p>Learn how to play the ukulele, including strumming, picking and melody</p> <p>Develop a sense of timing and awareness through playing and performing with others.</p> <p>Learn how to play some popular songs on the Ukulele as a class and in groups.</p> <p>Learn about harmony and melody.</p> <p>Arrange your music to include harmony and melody.</p>	<p>Animation.</p> <p>Students will engage in a cross curricular topic where they will create an animated version of the story they are learning in class 'The Dragon Slayer'</p> <p>Students will have a choice to either create stop motion, flip art or use an application to create their animation.</p> <p>Students will take the lead in researching and learning about how to create their chosen animation.</p>	<p>Drama</p> <p>Gain better understanding about character portrayal and voice projection.</p> <p>Learn new techniques for voice control.</p> <p>Be able to perform lines from memory.</p> <p>Learn and rehearse a Christmas themed play for the winter festival.</p>	<p>Music theory/Listening.</p> <p>Revise music theory previously learnt.</p> <p>Begin learning music theory for grade 1 or 2 ABRSM.</p> <p>Learn how to listen to music with a critical ear.</p> <p>Listen to different instruments of the orchestra and be able to pick them out in a piece of music.</p> <p>Start to use musical language to describe music.</p>	<p>Dance</p> <p>Learn some dance moves for hip hop style dancing.</p> <p>Learn to perform the dance moves correctly and in time.</p> <p>Learn a choreographed dance piece and perform it in time with each other and the music.</p> <p>Show awareness of style and body movements</p>	<p>Music Production & Composition.</p> <p>Learn about the importance of music production and how we can use it to compose our own music.</p> <p>Learn how to use Garageband and other programmes to compose their own original piece of music.</p> <p>Using the skills that the students have acquired in the previous blocks they should compose an original piece of music in a particular style e.g. scary music.</p>	<p>Recorder</p> <p>Extend learning from previous year learning more variety of notes and gaining better precision with finger positions and embouchure technique.</p> <p>Learn more complex songs that develop these skills.</p> <p>Learn songs that develop the ear through harmony.</p>



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
