Hand 1:

SETUP: Potawatomi Milwaukee 1-3 \$2400eff

PRE: BTN to \$15, Hero in SB As Ks 3! to \$55, BTN 4! \$200, Hero calls.. \$400

FLOP: Ac 8c 6h Hero checks, BTN bets \$200, Hero calls. \$800

TURN: Qs Hero checks, BTN bets \$350, Hero jams all-in \$2000 total..V1 calls w AKo

RIVER: chop chop

Hand 2:

SETUP: 2-5 Encore.. \$1k cap. \$1100eff

PRE: Hero MP \$20, 6c 5c HJ and CO call, BB calls. \$80

FLOP: Qc 6h 5s BB x, Hero bets \$80, f/f BB calls. \$240

TURN: 5d BB x, Hero checks behind.. \$240

RIVER: 7s BB bets \$125 Hero raises to \$400.. BB jams \$875 total.. Hero calls. SB has 57o

Hand 3: (non-hand call about rake set up at MGM National Harbor)

Both the 2/5 \$1k cap game and the \$1/3 \$500 cap game have rake of 10% up to \$5 + \$3 in promotional drops. \$2/5 typical open raise is to \$15 and gets 1-2 callers.. \$1/3 typical open is to \$15 and gets 2-4 callers.. Which is the better game to play? Bart discusses rake

consideration and how to calculate it as a function of average stack size.

Hand 4:

SETUP: London Hippodrome 2-5. 1.2keff

PRE: UTG limps, +1 to \$20, Hero in HJ AJss, 3! \$70, +1 calls. \$145

FLOP: Jd 6c 4s +1 x, Hero bets \$40, +1 calls. \$225

TURN: 2c +1 x Hero bets \$175, +1 calls. \$575

RIVER: 9c +1 bets \$475.. Hero folds. V1 shows Jh and claims Qh Jh ..
