Hand 1:

SETUP: Lucky Chances 3-5+\$10 \$1500 max, \$2200 eff

PRE: 7 handed.. Hero UTG Tc Td to \$30, CO calls, STRD 3! \$135, Hero calls, CO folds. \$300

FLOP: Jh Jc 5d STRD bets \$165, Hero calls. \$630

TURN: 6d STRD bets \$320 .. Hero calls. \$1270

RIVER: 7d STRD bets \$500.. Hero jams (as a bluff).. \$1600.. STRD calls... Hero wins!! no reveal

Hand 2: Brad K call

SETUP: TCH Social Dallas 2-5+10 \$1500 max \$1680eff

PRE: Hero HJ Ac As \$30, CO (Euro) 3! \$100, Hero calls. \$215

FLOP: 8s 7d 2h.. Hero checks, CO bets \$100, Hero calls. \$415

TURN: Jh Hero checks, CO bets \$300, Hero calls. \$1015

RIVER: 3s Hero checks, CO jams for \$1180, Hero calls. CO has JJ..

Hand 3:

SETUP: Halifax NV 2/5 9 handed 100-500 max \$2900eff

PRE: UTG limps (\$400 and he is a "habitual limp re raiser"), MP to \$50, Hero HJ AKss just calls, EP calls. \$150

FLOP: Ac Qs 7s UTG checks, MP jams \$2850.. Hero calls, UTG folds.

TURN: Qd

RIVER: 7h MP has QQ. Bart and the caller discuss this situation in terms of equity vs probable ranges and also the fact that they are so deep in this heavily restricted buy in scenario to other considerations come into play here (like possibly passing on a very close spot to stay this deep at a \$500 max game)?

Hand 4: (Non Hand call)

High Hand Promotion in effect which pays out \$400 to the highest hand made very half hour. A guy at the caller's table makes quad 5s with about 10 minutes left in the half hour for the current best high hand. There are only 8 or so current active tables in the room. The winning player asks if anyone wants to buy out his high hand for \$200 (50% of the payout) with 10 minutes left. And older guy accepts. A minute later the quads guy takes a phone call, racks up and leaves without saying anything. The casino will not involve themselves in this player agreement. The caller isn't sure if the winning high hand player can some back later to collect the full \$400 and the caller is from out of town so doesn't know if the players that made the agreements are regs.
