SETUP: Cherokee NC 2/5 match the stack. \$1800 eff

PRE: BTN opens to \$25, Hero in BB 3! to \$80 Jd Td BTN calls. \$160

FLOP: Jc 9s 8c Hero bets \$50, BTN calls. \$260

TURN: 8h Hero checks, BTN check behind. \$260

RIVER: Jh Hero bets \$200.. BTN raises to \$500.. Hero calls. BTN has 99..

Hand 2:

SETUP: Lucky Chances 3/5+\$10 \$1500

PRE: \$1580eff.. MP \$30, HJ calls, Hero 2s 2d calls BTN, BB and straddle call. \$150

FLOP: 8h 5h 2c x/x MP x/ HJ bets \$100, Hero calls.. f/f/f \$350

TURN: 7d HJ bets \$350.. Hero calls. \$1050

RIVER: 3s HJ jams all-in \$1100. Hero calls. HJ has 85s and Hero wins..

Hand 3:

SETUP: (Non Hand Call) Caller gets it in with AK preflop vs a drunk at 2/2 at Jax Bestbet. Caller misses the board for no pair, but the opponent asked for the dealer to table his own hand (the drunk won't turn his hand over). The opponent pushes his hand face down towards the dealer then stops him before the dealer mucks the cards. Grabs the dealer's arm and the cards drop out of the dealer's hand face up on the table.. Opponent has a pair. Floorman is called over and rules hand is retrievable. Tells dealer to push cards back to opponent (at this time hand is face down). Opponent walks away and cards are just sitting there face down. Then dealer tells floor that the hand was "tabled" because they had flipped over. Floor rules in the opponent's favor. What is a tabled hand? Does the player have to turn over his own cards?

Hand 4: (KIP Andrian)

SETUP: Crowne.. 5/5 \$1600 eff 6 Handed

PRE: Kc Js Hero raises to HJ \$20, SB calls. \$45.. SB (trying reg)

FLOP: Th 9c 4s .. SB x, Hero bets \$20, SB calls. \$85

TURN: Jc SB x/ Hero bets \$55.. SB calls. \$195

RIVER: 9s SB x.. Hero checks.. Opponent has KTdd..
