

## **Episode 291: One card flush blocker bluffs**

**100/200 60k EFF**

**UTG8 rec reg opens \$600 we BTN flat AsKd, BB calls(1900)**

**Flop Kh 9s 3s, BB X, UTG cbets \$1000, we call, BB folds(3900)**

**Turn Td he bets \$3000, we call (9900)**

**River 2s he bets \$4500.....**

- Preflop decision
  - Flat or 3B: reason on decision, main one fun players in BB
- Flop decision
  - You can make a case with our combo for sure to raise or call
- River decision
  - How hand played out, villain range is very skewed 2P+ minimum esp given his bet sizing otr
  - Spot where i think fold/raise > call

**100/200 45K EFF**

**UTG6 we AcTs \$600, reg next calls , SB calls ,and VIP in BB calls (2400)**

**Flop Tc 9s 6c xxxx around (2400)**

**Turn Qc BB leads \$3800 we call(10000)**

**River Ks BB leads \$9500.....we jam 30k more eff**

- Flop decision
  - As PFR to IP flat caller esp on this board should be/easiest strategy to implement is just check range
- Turn decision
  - Noting overbet sizing, big tell for villain will be weighted towards heavy value. Should probably overfold a lot of marginal hands ex a lot of overpairs esp no club fairly easy fold
  - Clear continue with our combo, mainly for the EQ on hitting a flush
- River decision
  - Another overbet

- Big assumption but my player profile reads here:
  - has a lot of give ups otr and waves white flag very often
  - Sizing makes me believe he has a flush here often
  - But villain does have a bet+fold button
    - Been losing a lot recently, definitely scared of the underbluffed river raise esp by regs
