Handcrafted artisan techniques combine a mix of delicately skip planed grain texture with the original patina saw marks. Character flooring comes with 60% - 70% of the original surface. The amount of remaining original antique character surface and can be controlled by sanding after installation, or we also offer a "light" character floor that only has roughly 30% of the original surface.

LIMITATIONS	Though reclaimed wood generally has a denser grain structure than new wood products, it does contain checks, marks, knotholes, nail holes, and color variations. Please allow for these natural variations when designing the application.
