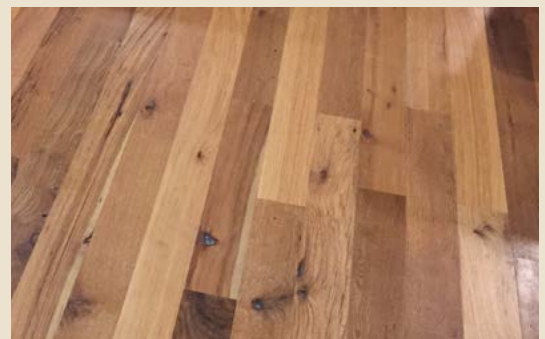
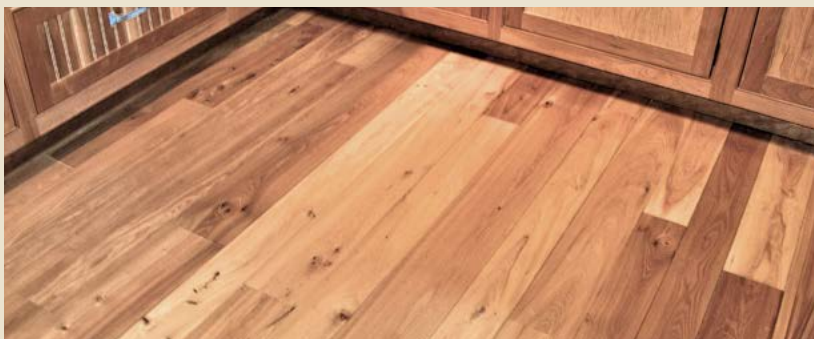

ORIGIN	All of our lumber is reclaimed from old barns, factories, and homes in the Eastern U.S. Wood is typically 100+ years old.	
DISCLAIMER	Each reclaimed board is one-of-a-kind and can possess some or all of the aged characteristics. Variation is to be expected.	
LIMITATIONS	Though reclaimed wood generally has a denser grain structure than new wood products, it does contain checks, marks, knotholes, nail holes, and color variations. Please allow for these natural variations when designing the application.	

Note: Random nail holes, knots, and nonstructural checks and cracks are inspected by expert craftspeople to ensure that customers only receive our guaranteed quality product of usable footage.
