Baleares International College Uniform Policy:

It is very important that all students follow the uniform code below. We are providing clear advice and guidance so that there can be no doubt as to what is expected.

- Students are expected to take responsibility for wearing the correct uniform and comply with this policy at all times whilst at school and on journeys to and from school.
- The school is a learning environment; this is reflected in the dress code and in the expectations we have of staff and students.
- The school uniform is an all-year uniform. During colder weather, girls may choose to wear tights or trousers, boys may choose to wear long trousers.
- The school reserves the right to exercise judgement at all times.

- BIC navy blazer - optional item

Students can choose:

- BIC school sweater
- BIC school cardigan
- BIC vest

Students can choose:

- BIC branded short sleeved shirt
- BIC branded long sleeved shirt
- *Shirts should be tucked into at all times.*

Please note: Polo shirts NOT permitted.

Students can choose:

- Grey trousers
- Grey skirt (knee-length)
- Grey shorts (*tailored and above the knee).
- Grey culottes
- School dress (students in EYFS to Year 6 only)

- **Socks:** must be grey and must be below the knee
- **Tights:** should be black, grey or opaque
- **Shoes:** must be black

SHOES

We wish to remind all students and their parents of the following school policy when buying school shoes.

Shoes need to be all black, be made of leather or synthetic leather and be sensible in style—No boots.

Boots are allowed but must be black leather, flat and ankle length.

Shoes with a coloured logo or coloured/white sole are not permitted. If shoes have laces, these must be black.

In the summer term, sandals may be worn but these **MUST** be either navy blue or black.

For students in Primary School we recommend a strong shoe that offers plenty of support.



JEWELLERY

Jewellery is not appropriate for school. The only permitted items are ONE watch (Smartwatches are not acceptable) and a pair of plain studs earrings - one per ear. Any other kind of jewellery will be confiscated. Facial piercings are not allowed under any circumstance.

HAIR

Hair should be natural colours only. Extreme haircuts or patterns cut into hair are not permitted. Hairstyles should be sensible and appropriate to the working environment.

Hair accessories: alic bands and scrunchies **MUST** be plain in design and be of muted/natural colours.





MAKE-UP

Discreet make-up may only be worn by students in Year 10 onwards. Nail extensions and accessories are not permitted. Nails must be kept short, and nail varnish should be clear in colour.



COATS

Coats are needed in the cold weather and should avoid inappropriate logos or design. These should be navy blue, dark grey or black. Hoodies, denim jackets, and any inappropriate or non-weatherproof coats are not permitted. Outdoor clothing (coats, gloves, scarves, etc) will be taken off indoors including classrooms, corridors and dining area. The optional school blazer can be worn indoors over the sweater, vest or cardigan.



BELTS

A belt, if worn, should be black with a plain buckle and should not be a fashion item.



GENERAL UNIFORM RULES

Uniform must always be correctly worn, including:

- **School Badges** (House badges and reward badges will be provided) are an integral part of the school uniform and must be worn at all times.
- The school **jumper** is an optional piece of uniform.
- **Shirts** must have the school logo and be tucked in at all times.
- **Trousers** and shorts must be grey and tailored and not rolled up under any circumstances.
- **Skirts** must be grey and tailored and a suitable professional length (no shorter than 5cm above the knee)
- **Shoes** must be black with sturdy leather and wide flat heels. Boots are allowed but must be black leather, flat and ankle length. Platforms, open toe shoes, trainers and fabric shoes are not permitted. Coloured laces or stitching are not permitted.
- **Socks** and **tights** should be plain black, grey or opaque.
- **Coats** should be black, navy or grey and only discreet logos are allowed. Coats should not be worn inside the school building at any time.
- **Hoodies** are not allowed in school.
- **Gloves, hats and scarves** should be black, blue or grey and plain. They should not be worn inside the school building at any times.



GENERAL UNIFORM RULES

Uniform must always be correctly worn, including:

- **Caps** should not be worn at any time around or on the way to school.
- **Bags** must be traditional school bags, suitable for students to carry their planner, books and equipment (including PE Kit). These can be either rucksacks, satchels, or messenger bags. We do not permit “handbags” style bags, even if they are large enough to contain books and folders.
- **Belts** must be plain black. Large buckles displaying logos are not permitted.
- **Jewellery** is strictly limited to the following; a watch with plain strap; small stud earrings, worn in the lower lobe of the ear. All necklaces and earrings must be removed for PE. No visible body piercing, including tongue studs, are allowed.
- **Hair**—all hairbands and scrunchies must be plain white, blue or black and of narrow width. No decorative hairbands, hair ties or ribbons are allowed. Hair must be worn in a simple style and must not be unnaturally coloured or have hair extensions.
- **Make-up**, if worn, must be for the skin only, natural and not noticeable. No eye or lip makeup is allowed.
- **Nail** varnish or nail extensions of any kind may not be worn.
- **Aerosol sprays** and perfumes may not be brought to the school.

SPORTS UNIFORM | PE KIT

Baleares International College has introduced a new sports kit and will be compulsory for all students to wear during PE lessons from **September 2020**.

It comprises of:

- BIC PE Shorts
- PE t-shirt
- PE fleece emblazoned with the logo.

These are available from our uniform supplier.

In cold weather students may wear plain blue navy tracksuit bottoms.

Socks must be plain White ankle socks. Navy blue socks are also acceptable to wear.
