Guiding light

The 'Lincoln' lantern is the second design to result from the ongoing partnership between lighting studio Hector Finch and Sir John Soane's Museum, WC2. It is an interpretation of the original copper lantern – classically proportioned with corners topped by the anthemion scrolls found in architectural detailing throughout the house – that hangs outside the entrance to the museum. "It was already beautifully simple; we just wanted to make it a little more modern," says Hector. Working with his wife Emma to remove some of the 'cluttered detail' at the top, he has created a version that is available in two sizes and three finishes: polished brass, antique brass and bronze. Prices start at £1,740 for a small 'Lincoln' lantern. hectorfinch.com | soane.org >
