HOT DESKING

HANG IT ALL

'Gwynn' is a beautifully balanced hanging lantern from ${\bf Jamb}$ in antique brass. The octagonal bell-shaped design has pierced quatrefoils in the upper fretwork, reminiscent of Gothic details, while the pagoda roof and scrolled terminals are a nod to the Chinese style popular in England during the 18th and 19th centuries.
