The healthcare-focused path concentrates on Electronic Health Records and CompTIA A+ certification and prepares you for the CEHRS and A+ exams. Whereas the more technical path is focused on CompTIA A+ and Network+ certifications. Students will choose their focus upon enrollment and will only take the two exams pertaining to their pathway.

After completing our program and passing the A+ exam and either the Network+ or Certified Electronic Health Records Specialist (CEHRS) exams, you'll be qualified for opportunities like Practice Workflow and Information Specialist, Management Redesign Specialist, Clinician/Practitioner Consultant, Implementation Support Specialist/Manager, PC Technician, Technical/Software Support Specialist, Technology Specialist and more!

Throughout the Healthcare IT Technician program, students will learn the skills to:

- Manage and troubleshoot a basic network infrastructure, using common ports and networking protocols
- Install and manage wired and wireless networks, adhering to standards and using modern testing tools
- Assess security risks and identify potential threats to hardware, software, and physical location
- Conduct risk mitigation for systems, hardware and peripherals
- Implement disaster recovery procedures and security contingency plans

Candidates with a felony conviction are not eligible to participate in ANY MedCerts program that includes the Pharmacy Technician certification as a primary or secondary certification

The student understands that MedCerts does not hold any control over the drug, immunization, criminal, or background screening processes or policies held by any organization outside of MedCerts.

Students are expected to take and pass the national certification exam through the issuing authority for recognized certification in their field.
