## PROGRAM DETAILS

This program prepares current and future IT professionals for a career in cybersecurity, with a focus on "offensive" strategies to protect an organization from risk. Penetration Testers or Pentesters (also known as Ethical Hackers) pro-actively test for security gaps and weaknesses within organizations of all sizes, across all industries.

As organizations scramble to protect themselves and their customers, the ability to conduct penetration testing is an emerging skill-set that is becoming ever more valuable to the organizations seeking protection, and ever more lucrative for those who possess these skills.

A Pentester plans and scopes a pen test engagement with a client, finds vulnerabilities, exploits them to get into a network, then reports on those findings to the client. These individuals are often referred to as "white hat" if they are hired or employed by an organization to provide ethical hacking or penetration testing as a service.

They are often self-employed or work through an agency. CompTIA PenTest+ is the only penetration testing exam taken at a Pearson VUE testing center with both hands-on, performance-based questions and multiple-choice, to ensure each candidate possesses the skills, knowledge, and ability to perform tasks on systems. PenTest+ exam also includes management skills used to plan, scope, and manage weaknesses, not just exploit them.

- Employ social engineering to uncover security holes (e.g. poor user security practices or password policies)
- Probe for vulnerabilities in web applications, fat/thin client applications and standard applications
- Pinpoint methods that attackers could use to exploit weaknesses and logic flaws
