

# New Jersey Dental Assistant Requirements

Certification or approved/accredited training is not required for entry-level Dental Assistant jobs. MedCerts graduates set themselves apart in a competitive job market by demonstrating to employers that they hold the knowledge and skills required for job - as proven through graduation and certification.

There are often additional job titles recognized by each state's board of Dentistry, each having requirements different from what is shown below. The most closely associated job title for qualified MedCerts graduates is shown within this document. For simplification and display purposes, the shortest or simplest pathway to eligibility as a MedCerts graduate is shown along with any additional requirements beyond program completion and/or certification.

## Immediate Eligibility & Scope of Practice

**Is dental assisting certification REQUIRED for entry level? NO**

**Entry Level New Jersey Dental Assistant Job Title:** Unregistered Dental Assistant<sup>1</sup>

**Will I be eligible for certification after completing my program through MedCerts? YES**

- MedCerts' Dental Assistant program has been reviewed and is approved by the American Medical Technologists (AMT) board, which upon completion qualifies the graduate to attempt the Registered Dental Assistant (RDA) Certification Exam.<sup>2</sup>

**Can I take dental X-rays? YES**, after completing NJ Dental Radiologic Technologist Requirements.<sup>3</sup>

**What else can I do as a NJ Unregistered Dental Assistant?** Each state develops their own State Practice Act which defines the allowable duties by title.<sup>4</sup>

### Post-Graduate/In-Field Career Advancement Opportunities

*New Jersey Registered Dental Assistant<sup>5</sup>*

- Obtain 2 year's work experience/ (3500 hours)
- Take the DANB CDA exam (Certified Dental Assistant)
- Pass the DANB Administered NJ Expanded Duties-General Exam
- Complete Online Orientation for NJ Jurisprudence
- Apply for licensure as RDA to the NJ State Board of Dentistry
