

Granor Farm Camp Counselor Job Description

Granor Farm Camp is a weekly summer program for children ages 5-10 years old. Each day, campers get dirty in the fields, work together problem solving in group projects, learn to cook with food they harvest, and create process-based nature art. They are asked to work with our farm staff and think creatively about what to make with the produce we grow. Campers learn about the food they eat and discover a love of trying something new, leaving Granor Farm with new friends, great ideas and lots of knowledge about how farm life works.

Our program includes activities that involve exploring the farm, Granor produce, cooking and group projects. Each week of camp will have a farm-related theme ranging from The Food We Grow to Playing in the Dirt.

Counselors are an integral part of Farm Camp. Each counselor will help implement the schedule for each day, work directly with children ages 5-10 and work to create a clean and safe environment for the campers. Counselors should enjoy being outside, keeping children engaged in activities and able to complete simple cleaning tasks. Counselors will report to the Camp Directors and should expect to take clear direction from them.

Ability to work a minimum of one week of camp to five weeks. Babysitting, previous counselor or other childcare experience a plus.
