## Who we are

We're Hubbub, a creative charity that's been inspiring positive environmental action since 2014. Every campaign is sparked by our passion to problem-solve and make greener choices easier and more possible for everyone – from food to fashion and from reuse to greener and more connected communities.

Alongside our campaigns, we run a social enterprise with plastic fishing as one of our key products. [Plastic Fishing](#) is a one-of-a-kind litter picking trip aiming to engage corporate employees with issues around plastic and marine pollution. Since 2019, we've taken out over 5,000 employees and school children, giving everyone a fun and impactful way to take action.

## What you'll do

---

Our workshop facilitators are the face of Hubbub during our plastic fishing sessions. You'll be our person on the ground, running the sessions and providing a great experience for our clients.

You'll be mainly working alongside other workshop facilitators and our amazing team of skippers at the sailing centre we use for our plastic fishing sessions. For longer sessions we have two facilitators on-board, so you'll work as a team to set up, pack down and run the sessions. The skippers are there to lead all the water-based parts of the trip. You'll also be in regular contact with the Development & Operations Coordinator, who books in the plastic fishing trips and will be your contact for all queries and questions!

**Your role will include:**

- Facilitating plastic fishing sessions for our corporate partners, including giving safety briefings and leading creative workshops around marine pollution.
- Joining client groups out on the water, talking to them about Hubbub, plastic pollution and providing encouragement.
- Providing logistical support on the day by setting up, clearing after the session and providing impact data on the rubbish collected.
- Generally assisting the sailors (clients) in having a good day and keeping up our positive relationship with the skippers.

## Who you are

---

- You are familiar with or excited by Hubbub's work and are keen to learn more and be an ambassador.
- You are interested in the key environmental issues and are willing to do some background reading on the topic.
- You are confident talking to large groups of people (up to 66 people at a time).
- You may have some facilitator experience.
