MARANDÚA

Synopsis

Four decades after the dream of a futuristic Amazonian city collapsed, a military base and foreign plantations remain. Local voices such us guardians, rebels, and shamans; unearth memories of disappearance and resistance, confronting the neocolonial tokenization of Indigenous peoples and the cultural and ecological extractivism rooted in the colonial mindset of those in power.

Andrés Jurado is a Colombian filmmaker, producer, and researcher. Co-founder and codirector of La Vulcanizadora, his work bridges non-fiction and experimental cinema, archival practices, and contemporary art to explore memory, coloniality, propaganda, and ecology, focusing on forgotten narratives and forms. He has produced Abrir Monte (2021) by Maria Rojas Arias; **Yvuuhza Okaina (2022), Tarro Vacío (2024)**, and **La Trampa (2024)** by filmmakers Ferney and Vitilio lyokina Gittoma (La Chorrera, Amazonas); and Bienvenidos Conquistadores Interplanetarios y del **Espacio Sideral (2024)** premiered at FIDMarseille.

He earned the Colombian Cinematographic Development Fund with the short film SON OF SODOM, which premiered in the Official Short Film Selection at Cannes 2020 and was selected for festivals such as IDFA, Zinebi-Bilbao, and Clermont-Ferrand. He produced the hybrid feature film ANHELL69, which premiered at the Venice International Critics' Week. He has participated in laboratories and markets such as IDFA Forum. Torino Film Lab. and CANNES DOC.

With fractured homes, the gang lures them as a surrogate family, while their coach Emilton offers fragile hope. His death ends both boxing and childhood. When Luis is murdered, Mauro is shattered and flees with Wendy to Bogotá, a journey that captures a generation of Caribbean youth searching for a better future.



Her short, **TWO-SPIRIT**, premiered at IDFA and Palm Springs, earning nominations from the Colombian Academy and the IDA Awards 2022, and was distributed by The New Yorker. **RED FLAG** competed at IDFA and was also nominated for the Macondo Awards. Her debut feature, **SOUL OF THE DESERT**, premiered at Venice's Giornate degli Autori, where it won the Queer Lion, and later screened at major festivals worldwide, earning multiple awards before its theatrical releases in Colombia and Brazil. She is currently developing **FROM THE HOOD and QUEEN OF THE PEOPLE**.

Colombian production company founded in 2017. Based in Cartagena and Bogotá, it produces and co-produces films, television, and series, with a focus on arthouse cinema that explores new perspectives along with social strategies.
