It all starts with literacy

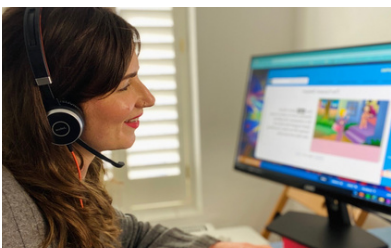
38%
