## How We Do It

A Threat Check is a team effort. It begins with the installation of specialized tools to obtain a complete picture of your IT environment. Our detection specialists and threat hunters then perform daily analyses and reviews of your IT environment.

Threat hunting is the process of proactively and iteratively performing deep and sophisticated searches within your IT environment, as well as analysis of behaviors, activities, or other events that are considered suspicious. During this stage, various types of clues are actively located and mapped, which may indicate past or ongoing attacks.

If an ongoing attack is identified, services are offered by our Incident Response Team to effectively and immediately manage the attack.

Following the analysis, a Threat Check Report will be produced. This report will include information on whether any active or previous attacks were detected during the analysis period (an active attack will have been immediately communicated), and prioritized best practice recommendations to manage identified vulnerabilities and improve the resilience of your IT environment.

The following combination of factors enables Truesec to identify a wide and complex range of advanced threats and attacks:

### Initiation

- The assessment is planned in detail.

### Execution

- The analysis is conducted based on the prescribed conditions.

### Reporting

- Meetings are scheduled remotely, or on-site if necessary.
