EIS AND INTERMARK RESPOND TO FAQ

Which residential areas should I choose to be close to the school?

Residential real estate in the western district is in demand among foreigners due to the important advantages of this area: modern and well-maintained residential neighborhoods developed social structure, well-developed transportation system, as well as a good environmental situation. The most popular residential complexes: Business-class residential complex «Kvartal on Leninsky» located at 92 Leninsky Ave., Business-class Residential complex «Well house» located at 111 Leninsky Ave., Business-class Residential complex «West Side» located at Udaltsova Street, 85A.

Do I need to buy a car in order to move around the city?

Moscow is the largest city in Europe with a population of more than 12 million people, so traffic will always be problematic. You can hire a full-time or part-time driver to drive the car or use numerous cab ordering apps. The fastest and inexpensive way to get around Moscow is the Moscow metro. The entrances are marked with a big red letter "M". There is plenty of English on the metro signs, so navigating your way around this big city can be quite easy.

Where to buy clothes for a child to school – pants, skirts, shoes?

EIS has school uniform. School offers different items of tops such as white and green polo shirts, green v-neck jumpers, fleece jackets, cardigans, sweatshirts with school logo on it. 3arents can purchase these items in school. All children should wear gray or black bottoms and have indoor shoes. Skirts, pants, shoes for school can be purchased in local shopping malls near the school such as: Detskiy Mir (37 Vernadsky Prospekt, Bldg. 337, floor 1), Mama's Loft for little kids (95 Leninsky Ave), Kenguru (ul. Stroiteley, 1 / Leninsky Ave, 74).

How do I pay for parking?

In Moscow, parking may be free or paid. A large amount of paid parking facilities are located within the Garden Ring Road; on the Boulevard Ring area, parking service will cost you \$2.5 per hour, within the Garden Ring Road - \$1.8 per hour. For parking payment, we recommend using the following options: Web-site/Mobile app Moscow Parking.

Where should I take my child to sports and art classes other than school?

EIS offers a big range of extra-curricular activities such as touch-rugby, badminton, football, chess, art club, and Chinese language, however there is also a possibility to take your child for extra sport lessons in sport centers located close to school such as: Academy of Ice Hockey (ul. Michurinskiy prospect, Olimpic Village, 2), Chess First (Prospect Vernadskogo, 93), Swimming Pool Harmony (Smory Mashela ul., 6 bld.4), etc.

What are medical centers close to school where I can take my child to see a doctor?

K+31 have English speaking pediatricians and other staff. Other clinics with English-speaking staff in Moscow are GMS Clinic (1 Nikoloschepovsky per. 6, p. 1), AO "Medicine" (2nd Tverskoy-Yamskaya per. 10), EMC Clinic.





WESTERN ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT OF MOSCOW

The districts located in a prestigious district of Moscow in in the western administrative district with well-developed infrastructure and transport, and about a quarter of its territory is occupied by green spaces.

It is suitable for those who value aesthetics and greenery. The district's calling card is the main building of Lomonosov Moscow State University, one of the legendary Stalinist skyscrapers. There are many authentic historical buildings and modern buildings, on its northern border are the Botanical Garden and the Great Lawn of Moscow State University. Along the western part runs the Setun River Valley nature reserve zone with the Ramenka River. The area also has the All-Russian Academy of Foreign Trade and the famous embassy town on Mosfilmovskaya Street. The cultural and sports infrastructure is actively developing.

Numerous institutes and the university were built in many areas of the district during the Soviet era, causing nearby houses to serve as homes for their employees: university professors, researchers, and students.
