

Pendant Pairing Instructions

SureSafe Alarm Button Options:

SureSafe Alarms can be paired with either pendant alarm buttons or wristband alarm buttons

Each SureSafe Alarm can be 'paired' with a maximum of 2 alarm buttons at any one time. For example, you can have 2 pendants 'paired' with the alarm, or you can have 1 x pendant and 1 x wristband.

Please note that you can never have more than 2 alarm buttons paired at any one time so if you have purchased a Wristwatch Combo Product then one of your pendants will be a spare (in case one is damaged or misplaced).

Pendant 'Pairing' Instructions:

Please follow these instructions to 'pair' new or replacement pendants with your SureSafe Alarm (you do not need to follow these instructions if you have received a new SureSafe Alarm as they will already be paired).

- Turn on the alarm. As soon as you hear the beep then press and hold the blue 'help' button on the main unit.
- 2. Hold for 5 seconds until the red light on top of the unit stays lit.
- 3. When the red light is constantly lit, keep hold of the blue button and press the button on the pendant/wristband you are looking to 'pair'.
- 4. You will hear a single beep, at which point you can release the buttons.
- 5. You have now paired the alarm button.
- 6. You can repeat this process for additional alarm buttons remembering that you can only pair 2 at any one time.

Pendant & Wristband Batteries:

All orders come complete with new batteries in the wristbands and pendants. Batteries should last a minimum of 1 year but can last well in advance of 2 years. Batteries are replaceable.

The correct LED colours are:

Pendant	Green	Red
Wristband	Bold Red	Pale/Light Red
