SUMMARY OF POSITION

Act as a representative of JCOS by leading, educating and conveying the JCOS mission to volunteers on outdoor stewardship projects throughout our parks.





DUTIES

- ▶ Represent JCOS by being a visible presence in our parks.
- ► Lead volunteer groups in safe and successful group projects.
- ► Complete a report after each project, tracking volunteer hours and work accomplished statistics.

REQUIREMENTS

- ► Be in good physical condition.
- ► All volunteers must complete a background check before working with visitors.
- ► Volunteers must abide by the JCOS Volunteer Handbook.
- ► Volunteers must follow Crew Leader uniform guidelines.
- Complete required training and mentoring.
- ► Lead a minimum of 2 group projects a calendar year.

AVAILABLE SHIFTS

- ► Flexible and determined by the volunteer, based on availability
- ► Group projects typically occur Monday through Friday and occasionally on weekends

TRAINING

- ► JCOS Volunteer Orientation for all new volunteers (2 hours)
- Crew Leader training (2 hours)
- ▶ Mentoring process requires a volunteer to lead a minimum of 2 projects while being shadowed by JCOS staff. At the conclusion of the 2 projects JCOS staff and the volunteer will determine if they are ready to be certified.

- Enhance your leadership skills.
- ► Receive training in safety and resource management.
