

2022 Trail Fund Projects Awarded

The Trail Fund's inaugural year brought 291 project proposals totaling over \$3.2 million. Seven great projects were able to be funded. The Trail Fund is administered by the Trails Move People Coalition, a diverse coalition of trail user groups led by American Trails. This fund supports grants for trail maintenance, research, and stewardship training across the country, serving all types of trail users.
