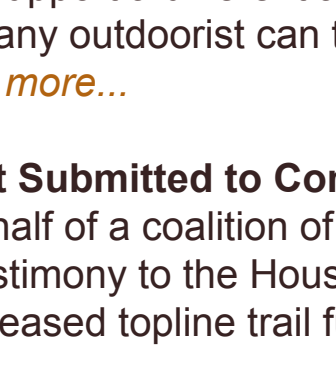
### National Recreation Trail Highlight: Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area Water Trail

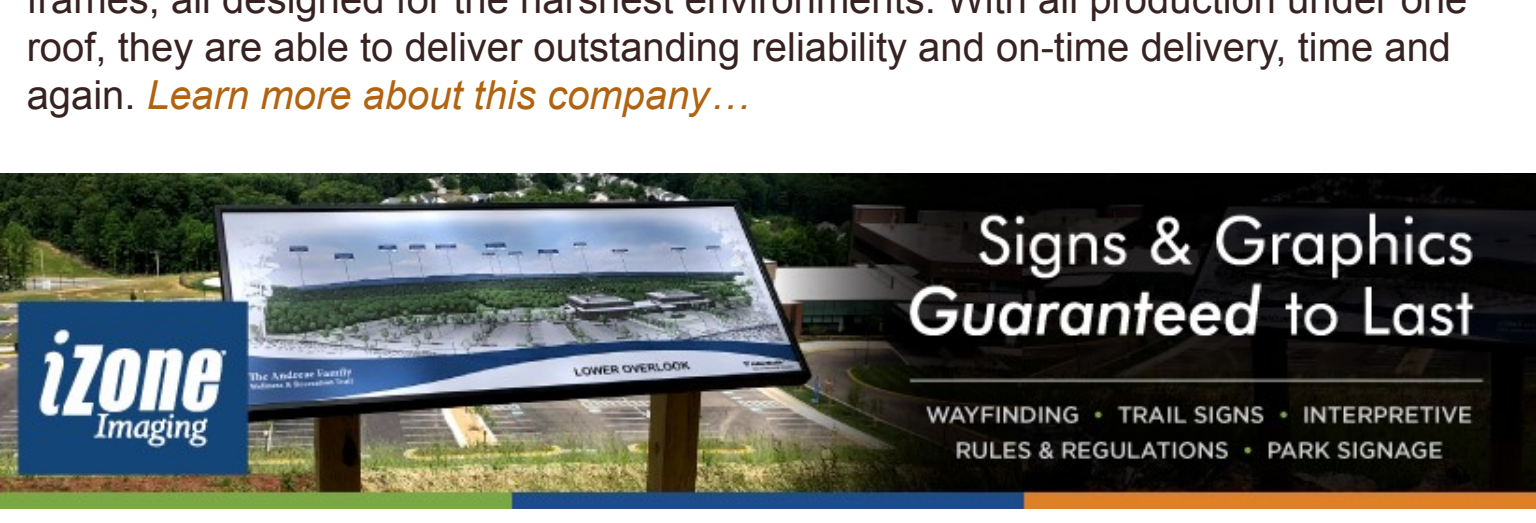
