








- The K&P Trail is a rail-to-trail conversion that travels north from the City of Kingston on the shores of Lake Ontario to the town of Renfrew on the Ottawa River.
- Of 150 total km, approximately 90 km are "developed"
- Frontenac County is host to approximately 85 km, of which 55 have been "developed" todate.
  - Remaining 30 km is used primarily by motorized trail users, but these sections are not yet "managed"
- The K&P Corridor plays a key connection in the development of a network of rail trails emerging across Eastern Ontario consisting of:
  - Ottawa Valley Rail Trail
  - Tay-Havelock Trail
  - Cataraqui Trail





























