

Outdoor recreation lifestyle, social media, internet

#### Hudson Highlands Fjord Trail

- Short term: address safety and parking issues at Breakneck Ridge
- Long term: develop a destination linear park in the Hudson Highlands
- Not a Parks project, not on Parks property






### **Data Collection**

- Baseline for management decisions
  - Capture existing impacts and evaluate future imapacts
- Spatial data collection on Breakneck and surrounding trails
  - Degraded areas (trampling)
  - Social Trails
  - Vandalism
  - Trail Conditions (widening, erosion)
  - Trail Intersection Counts



- Confirming assumptions
- Some surprises
- Survey available if interested






# Managing visitation

Existing frameworks & resources

- LAC, VERP, VUMF
- Great foundation for mgmt. decisions
- Challenging to implement

Takeaways:

- Think beyond just carrying capacity
- Education is key (informed vs uninformed)
- Face-to-face interactions = change behavior








#### Most Hikers in a Single Day





- Generated Hot Spot report with recommendations.

#### WARNING: This Is Not Just a Walk in the Park!

Breakneck Ridge is a steep rock scramble that is for experienced hikers in excellent physical condition only.

You are about to ascend 1,250 feet in only 3/4 mile. This hike should not be attempted by anyone with a fear of heights. Do not climb alone or in adverse weather conditions.

In the course of this hike, you will be treated to breathtaking views and will have the option to connect to a variety of other trails here in Hudson Highlands State Park Preserve.

> The recommended route is the White Trail to Red Trail to Yellow Trail. This takes an average of 3 hours to complete.

#### TIP:

Download Avenza's free "PDF Maps" app on your smartphone and search for "Hudson Highlands State Park Trail Map North" to have your GPS-enabled device show where you are located on the trail! For the safety of you and other hikers. please do the following: Bring a trail map and plenty of water. Stay on marked trails at all times. Wear proper hiking gear. Remove all garbage.





#### What are we doing from here?

- Trailhead Stewards
- Planning/management report
- Hot Spot report recommendations
- Signage & wayfinding improvements
- Additional data collection/surveys
- Graffiti removal
- Challenges: Staffing, funding, restoration, dispersal





#### Takeaways

- Data collection is valuable & informative
  - Monitor trends
  - Evaluate management strategies
  - Confirm/disprove assumptions
- Visitor management is more than a number
  - Informed users = less impacts
- Active vs. passive management techniques
- Face to face interactions: effective and positive
  - Communicate with a person rather than a sign
  - Leave No Trace messaging
