




- We went enmasse to City Council meeting.

Landmark conducted a study, telephone polls and surveys and hosted several community forums. These forums were the most attended community forumsever!









The result is a comprehensive system of improvement projects that are "doable" with resources available and without major shifts in public funding, and makes the pedestrian environment safer and easier to navigate
