

#### You + Transportation = \$\$\$\$

- Knowing your transportation teammates can accelerate your trail development, especially for urban trails
- In Portland, OR \$2.8 million is spent each year on trails with transportation funds
- Double what Oregon will get in RTP funds statewide
- Still this is less than 10% of potential flexible funds (\$25 million) & a mere fraction of the \$630 million available in the region.
