HARRISON LODGE

During the height of the Covid-19 pandemic, Windsor House built a new Covid-secure visitation lodge.

Harrison Lodge is fitted with key safety measures, keeping you and your loved one safe in the event of future outbreaks and without the need to wear PPE, for a more comfortable, relaxed visit. The lodge boasts separate entrances for residents and visitors, a fully-sealed antireflective Perspex screen divider, air conditioning and heating systems to ensure optimum temperatures, an integrated amplification and hearing loop communication system, and an automatic sanitisation system to prevent risk of contamination.
