The Standish Care Village is a unique setting in the North West, providing a continuity of care like no other in the region which creates a home for life.

Catering for respite, residential, nursing, dementia and advanced dementia care, those who move into a home within the Village have the security to know they will always have a home, and the relationships they create will continue to flourish under the same Millennium Care ethos.

All homes within the Village, Langtree, Lakeside and Worthington Lake, have private access to a local lake nestled within the Douglas Valley. Specialised staff support the daily needs of the residents and include a Music Ambassador and an Occupational Therapist.

The Village is centred around community, not only the strong connections and shared learning between the homes, but also the connection to the surrounding communities.

HOUSEHOLD MODEL

The building's architecture has been thoughtfully designed based on evidence-backed principles, ensuring that those who live with us do so in small clusters so they can profit from the environment's powerful but subtle therapeutic benefits.

This enables us to adopt a household model of care, with small group living to reduce stress, open-plan spaces that support independent wayfinding, and social areas centred around the dining experience because we believe the kitchen is often the heart of the home.

SETTING & TECHNOLOGY

Langtree utilises the latest in technologies to implement the very best care for residents, starting with MargoAI! The machine-assisted resource by Care Control aims to make care more efficient, allowing staff to focus on their relationships and providing personal care to the residents.

The location of the home ensures that those who live with us are connected to nature and its seasons, bringing serendipity and spontaneity to individual, communal and social interactions. We encourage residents to bring their wellies, a rain jacket, umbrella and a sunhat!

FOOD

Our food offering is as homely as it is wholesome. Through a deep understanding of ingredients and their alignment with gut and cognitive health, our vision is to create a daily dining experience that tastes as good as it makes you feel.

A specially equipped in-house gym ensures all who live at Langtree are supported by regular movement. A perfect combination of physiotherapy and fitness, joining the mind and body in unison.

The Group's Occupational Therapist plays a vital role in supporting residents' independence, safety and quality of life. Improving mobility makes a huge impact on those with dementia and nursing needs.
