

Beginning Sewing 1 & 2

Have fun learning how to read a pattern, follow a cutting layout, learn/review basic sewing techniques, complete samples used with WOVEN fabrics. By the end of this class, you'll have incorporated newly learned techniques into your chosen project!

Homework: Finishing any work not completed during class time.

Skill Level: This class is for the confident beginner who knows how to thread their machine and fill the bobbin. New to sewing or simply wants a refresher and/or learn a different approach.

Project Materials

PATTERN: Purchased, NOT designed for Knit fabrics, if you have a pattern, you think is similar to a pattern on the suggested list bring it with you to session 1 for teacher approval.

Jayne will have some patterns available for purchase at session 1)

WOVEN FABRIC: plain or twill weave, fiber content; cotton, linen, rayon or blend, pre-washed & pressed according to fiber content

ALL-PURPOSE THREAD: Any color for 1st session, thread to match project for sessions 2-4.

NOTIONS: identified in chosen pattern such at elastic, bias tape, buttons, etc.
