Class Goal: Learn basic sewing techniques with fun projects.

- a. Basic understanding of a sewing machine and how it works.
- b. How to read a pattern.
- c. How to cut a pattern.
- d. Learn basic stitches.
 - I. Straight stitch.
 - II. Zig Zag stitch.
 - III. Possibly other stitches.

Class Sewing Basic Materials:

Items may be purchased at Montavilla, Mill End, or any local sewing store.

- **1. Sewing Basket.** (For example, a shoe box, plastic container, or a basket to keep their supplies).
- 2. The Basic Sewing Kit:
 - a. Scissors' (small) for small hands.
 - b. Thread, White or color to match the material.
 - c. Machine sewing needle (80/12).
 - d. Basic hand sewing needle (small) for project sewing.
 - e. Straight pins.
 - f. Safety pins of all sizes.
 - g. Pin cushion or something to put their straight pins in.
 - h. Water transfer marker.
 - i. Sewing gauge.
 - j. Measuring tape.
 - k. Seam ripper.
 - I. Corner turning tool of some kind.
 - m. Hook and loop tape, (Non-Sticky Velcro).
 - n. Another helpful tool but not required is a Pinking shear.

Project: Fun Tote Bag

- a. Material: 1 ½ yard for main fabric, 1 ½ yard for lining.
- b. Any colorful buĚ ons or anything they want to add to the bag
