Day of Class

Sewing Machine w/scissors, snips, fabric markers, rotary cutter, pins or clips 75/11 needle

Bobbin 30-90wt thread color to match the background fabric or white Monofilament clear nylon or polyester thread

Cotton quilting thread/color of your choice to match or contrast your background color Regular foot that will accommodate straight and zig-zag stitch *Optional*:

Zig zag foot

Walking foot

Front and Backing: 2 fat quarters or ½ yd. Try to make the background a contrasting or complementary color to your scrappy applique colors.

Scrappy Appliques Colors: 5 different scraps measuring approximately 8 1/2" by 8 1/2""

You can choose colors by working from a color wheel to find: Different hues, tints, shades, colors, and values: <u>I like this one.</u>

Binding: You will need approximately (3) 2.5" strips by LOF (selvage to selvage) Approximately 1/8 yard or a fat quarter.

One of your scrappy applique colors could also be the binding or go wild and choose a separate color.
