On the night

Doors will open at 6.30 pm and the game will begin promptly at 7:15 pm. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before to sign in and collect your welcome drink.

Game play

The guests role during our murder mystery event is to play the detective. There will be four suspects (played by our actors) on the night which you will interview and examine their evidence to work out "Whodunnit". Sleuth packs will be handed out for you and your guests to complete as you try to discover who the murderer is, their motive and method.



Conduct

We want to keep this game a fun experience for everyone and reserve the right to refuse entry to or remove visitors who arrive inebriated, behave inappropriately with our staff, or are otherwise disruptive. The actors will not touch you, so please do not touch them. There will be no jump scares during the evening.

Accessibility

Please note that due to the limited accessibility of our Grade II* listed building, some areas of the game are not accessible for visitors with limited mobility. If you have specific access needs, please get in touch.

Dietary Requirements

If you have any dietary requirements you must make us aware at least three weeks before the event, but preferably sooner. We do not have an onsite kitchen and therefore need to order the food with our caterers in advance.

Costume

Costume is not required but you are encouraged to dress up if you would like. This event is set in 1922, so think flappers, gangsters, and flat caps.

We recommend wearing flat, comfortable shoes as you will be touring the Museum. The building can get cold, so you may want to bring a coat. There will be a coat rail on site.
