## **GUEST JUDGES**



Kolton Krouse, originally from Gilbert, Arizona, began their training at the age of 9 at Tempe Dance Academy. While attending their 2nd Year at The Juilliard School, they were simultaneously performing in the Broadway Revival of CATS the Musical every night as Tumblebrutus. Most recently seen in the Broadway Bound, Bob Fosse's Dancin', Kolton was also in the film Adaptation of the Musical, Freddie Falls In Love as Madame K, Fosse/Verdon as the Kit Kat Dancer, Westworld, Last Week Tonight with John Oliver, and The Late Show with James Corden. An alumni of Juilliard, Kolton was named Dance Magazines Top 25 to Watch.



Originally from Illinois, Abby began dance training at the age of 5. She graduated from Marymount Manhattan College with a BFA in Dance. The choreographers and repertoire that she performed included original and renowned pieces by Robert Battle, Jenn Freeman, Gabrielle Lamb, Jacqulyn Buglisi, Trey McIntyre, and Michael Waldrop. Abby spent summer breaks studying at the Graham School in NYC, working with Alexandra Damiani, and attending the River North Dance Chicago and Hubbard Street Summer Intensives. She has performed at The Joyce Theater, the Lincoln Center, Sony Hall, and The Auditorium Theater in Chicago. Abby danced with CoreDance Contemporary for their 2021-22 season, and is working on multiple video short films to be released in 2022-23. Currently, Abby is touring with NYCDA as an assistant and head of the "Ready, Set, Dance!" Program.



Born in North Carolina, Savannah moved to NYC in 2011 on scholarship to Broadway Dance Center's Professional Semester where she performed for Glamour and Details Magazines' End of the Year Celebration and NYC's Choreographer's Canvas. She attended The University of the Arts on scholarship and performed works by Douglas Becker, Roni Koresh and Sidra Bell. She traveled to France, performed in RAW: Artists of Philadelphia, World of Dance, and The Capezio Ace Awards. In 2016 her short film, Ame was selected by the Philadelphia Screendance Festival. She was casted in "POWER: A Concept Dance Video," under the direction of Josh Drake and Kellen Stancil and performed in 'Broadway Bares: Take Off".. Savannah most recently performed in the Halloween Special of 'Good Morning America.' She is currently on Faculty at Steps on Broadway and Ballet Academy East.



JORDAN PELLITERI

Born in Scottsdale, Arizona, Jordan Pelliteri grew up training at Plumb Performing Arts Center. She attended NYCDA throughout her training and was awarded the mini, junior, and senior national outstanding dancer title. She attended one year at Marymount Manhattan College and then decided to continue her studies at Arts Umbrella in Vancouver, British Columbia. There, Jordan went on to work with artists and choreographers such as Crystal Pite, Lukas Timulak, Medhi Walerski, Tom Weinberger, and Yvan Dubruielle. In February 2018, Jordan and others from Arts Umbrella debuted in Ballet BC's Romeo and Juliet choreographed by Medhi Walerski. As of August 2018, Jordan became a company member dancing with Nederlands Dans Theatre 2. Since then, she has went on to perform new works and repertoire works by Jiri Kylian, Alexander Ekman, Marco Goeke, Sharon Eyal, and Paul Lightfoot and Sol Leon. Jordan has won two YAGP choreography awards and two national critics choice awards for her choreography from NYCDA nationals.

# **AUDITIONING @ NYCDA**

- The NYCDA audition process is designed to be supportive and educational a great place to learn! Expect some informal discussion about approaching a professional audition.
- Dancers should wear their assigned numbers in EVERY class both Saturday and Sunday.
- For best visibility, place ONE number on the UPPER body above the heart. Extra numbers are included. Additional numbers can be requested at the Registration desk.
- Attendance is important in all workshop classes. The Faculty are observing the entire weekend.
- The audition consists of combinations taught as part of the NYCDA workshop.
- Audition class is only open to auditioning dancers and registered teachers. No parent observers.
- Finalists will be selected in each age division numbers will be announced (no names).

### SENIORS (ages 16-19) and TEENS (ages 13-15)

- The Senior/Teen Audition Class is Saturday 10:00-11:15am in the Teen Room.
- All dancers will perform BOTH a ballet and jazz combination. No one is eliminated until finalists are announced.
- Senior and Teen Scholarship Winners and Runners-Up will be announced at the end of the Convention Finale.

### JUNIORS (ages 11-12) and MINIS (ages 7-10)

- During the Sunday morning Jazz classes, in both the Junior and Mini Rooms, a casual, preliminary audition is held and finalists are chosen.
- Mini finalists join Junior finalists in the Junior room at 10:30am Sunday (beginning of lunch) for the Finalist Audition consisting of ballet and jazz.
- A special class for the Mini/Junior non-finalists is available in the Mini Room, while finalists are auditioning in the Junior Room.
- Junior and Mini Scholarship Winners and Runners-Up will be announced at the end of the Finale.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Dancers must be registered for the entire two-day workshop (age as of January 1, 2023)
- Once you have won as either a Regional Outstanding Dancer or Runner-Up for the 2022-2023 Regional Season, you may continue to audition for other special scholarships in another city, but may not re-audition for Outstanding Dancer.
- Independent Dancers will be considered for Regional Convention Scholarships, sponsorship scholarships, and special awards. Independent Dancers are NOT eligible to audition for Outstanding Dancer Scholarships.

In 2016, he was honored by the Actors Fund and Career Transitions For Dancers for 'outstanding contributions to the world of dance'. In 2014, *Dance Studio Life* magazine recognized Joe's efforts by presenting him with their first ever "Generous Heart Award".

Joe is most passionate about his work as the Executive Director of the NYC DANCE ALLIANCE. He enjoys traveling the country, nurturing future generations of dancers and discovering new talent. He is always cultivating new projects, often utilizing the talents of his NYCDA dancers. 

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

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
