Sydney recently completed a year-long contract with Royal Caribbean Cruise Line in the hit Broadway show "Grease The Musical" as an ensemble dancer and understudy (Marty Maraschino, Patty Simcox, and Cha Cha DiGregorio). She then set sail as a principal dancer, guest artist and associate choreographer for Virgin Voyages. Sydney appears in Season 4 of "The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel" as a principal dancer, working with Emmy-winning choreographer Marguerite Derricks. She was involved in the pre-production of "Schmigadoon" Season 2 and the upcoming Broadway show "Death Becomes Her" with Tony Award-winning choreographer Christopher Gatelli.



GRACIE ANDERSON

Gracie just wrapped up two years touring with the Broadway National tour of CATS as a Dance Captain and Swing. She grew up training and competing in Latin, Standard and Smooth ballroom styles all around the world. She is honored to be a 13x top six finalist at NDCA's U.S. Nationals in the Latin and Standard championships. As a two-time national champion, she represented the U.S. at the WDC World Championships in Paris, France placing 14th in Youth Latin and 8th in the Fred Astaire Cup. She went on to graduate from Marymount Manhattan College as the Gold Key recipient for her BFA in Dance, concentrating in ballet. While at MMC, she performed works by Robert Battle, Gerald Arpino, Jessica Lang, Jessica Hendricks and Gabrielle Lamb and was accepted to The School at Jacob's Pillow's Contemporary program. Gracie can be seen on FOX TV series: Sons of Tucson as a principle dancer and was a dancer in Royal Family's production, "Women on Fire". You can find her teaching guest classes at Steps on Broadway or touring as a faculty demonstrator, guest teacher and judge with the NYCDA convention.



JESSICA

Jessica's Broadway Credits include: CATS, Thoroughly Modern Millie, Thou Shalt Not, and Swing!. She has toured nationally with CATS, Swing!,(for which she won a best ensemble Ovation Award for), On The Town, Cabaret and Thoroughly Modern Millie as the Dance captain. Jessica was last seen performing on the new TV series, Modern Love and On stage as Rosie in Mamma Mia. She was a Principal dancer at the age of 14 with the Albano Ballet Company of America and the Hartford Ballet. She Co-created several Ballets for the New Jersey Ballet Company and has assisted Josh Bergasse installing several shows for Princess and Regent Cruise Lines.

Jessica is currently a Faculty member of ONSTAGE NY and a returning guest teacher at Wagner College. She is a NASM Certified Personal Trainer, specializing in corrective exercises for injuries, and received her Nutrition Coaching Certification. You can find her on the mic as a Lead Teacher Trainer for the Pure Barre NYC metro team.

Originally from Naperville Illinois, Abby began her dance training at the age of 5. She graduated from Marymount Manhattan College in 2020 with a BFA in Dance and was presented with the Gold Key honor for the Jazz concentration. 



WORKSHOP

WRISTBANDS

- Divided by color per age (see flyer).
- One day workshop dancers will only receive a bracelet.
- Must be worn on the wrist at all times. This includes observers.
- Do not need to remove for competition.
- Changes permitted via Studio only.

SCHOLARSHIP NUMBERS

- 3 provided for dancers registered for full weekend.
- Wear in all classes (except FNS).
- Faculty needs to see the color please do not cut.

SHOWCASE DANCERS

- Studio selected by registered teacher. One for each age division.
- Special shoutouts and groups in class.

AUDITIONS

- Teens & Senior audition Takes place Saturday morning.
 - Finalists announced at the last class on Sunday.
- Mini & Junior audition Takes place on Sunday.
 - Finalists announced immediately following audition.
 - All Mn/Jr finalists reconvene in the Junior room.
 - Non-finalists invited to special class in mini room.
- All dancers wearing a number including those who have already won OD this season should attend.
- Finalists are not the automatically Outstanding Dancers.
- Scholarship recipients announced at convention finale.

COMPETITION

SCHEDULE

 Performers should be ready to perform 1 hour prior to their scheduled performance time.

• DRESSING ROOMS

- Open 45 minutes prior to the start of competition.
- Photos and videos are strictly prohibited in the dressing room.
- May not be used for rehearsal space.
- Please keep the space clean and dispose of trash when leaving.

PROPS



STAGE

- Our stage is 40' wide by 32' deep, with sufficient wing space and a backstage crossover.
- Covered with marley for safety and performance quality.

PHOTO/VIDEO

- No photos or videos are permitted during competition.
- You may purchase professional photos and videos from EVOLVE in the main lobby!

AUDITIONING @ NYCDA

- The NYCDA audition process is designed to be supportive and educational a great place to learn! Expect some informal discussion about approaching a professional audition.
- Dancers should wear their assigned numbers in EVERY class both Saturday and Sunday.
- For best visibility, place ONE number on the UPPER body above the heart. Extra numbers are included. Additional numbers can be requested at the Registration desk.
- Attendance is important in all workshop classes. The Faculty are observing the entire weekend.
- The audition consists of combinations taught as part of the NYCDA workshop.
- Audition class is only open to auditioning dancers and registered teachers. No parent observers.
- Finalists will be selected in each age division numbers will be announced (no names).

SENIORS (ages 16-19) and TEENS (ages 13-15)

- The Senior/Teen Audition Class is Saturday in the Teen Room.
- All dancers will perform BOTH a ballet and jazz combination. No one is eliminated until finalists are announced.
- Senior and Teen Scholarship Winners and Runners-Up will be announced at the end of the Convention Finale.

JUNIORS (ages 11-12) and MINIS (ages 7-10)


- During the Sunday morning Jazz classes, in both the Junior and Mini Rooms, a casual, preliminary audition is held and finalists are chosen.
- Mini finalists join Junior finalists in the Junior room at 10:30am Sunday (beginning of lunch) for the Finalist Audition consisting of ballet and jazz.
- A special class for the Mini/Junior non-finalists is available in the Mini Room, while finalists are auditioning in the Junior Room.
- Junior and Mini Scholarship Winners and Runners-Up will be announced at the end of the Finale.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Dancers must be registered for the entire two-day workshop (age as of January 1, 2026)
- Once you have won as either a Regional Outstanding Dancer or Runner-Up for the 2025-2026 Regional Season, you may continue to audition for other special scholarships in another city, but may not re-audition for Outstanding Dancer.
- Independent Dancers will be considered for Regional Convention Scholarships, sponsorship scholarships, and special awards. Independent Dancers are NOT eligible to audition for Outstanding Dancer Scholarships.


All entries awarded Platinum, High Gold, Gold, High Silver, and Silver qualify for the NYCDA 2026 National Season Finale!





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

Joe is most passionate about his work as the Executive Director of the **NYC DANCE ALLIANCE.** He enjoys traveling the country, nurturing future generations of dancers and discovering new talent. He is always cultivating new projects, often utilizing the talents of his NYCDA dancers. In 2010, Joe Lanteri founded the **NYC DANCE ALLIANCE FOUNDATION**, as a vehicle to invest in gifted teenagers hoping to pursue their education and their love of the performing arts. Joe is also the Executive Director of **ONSTAGE NEW YORK**, offering another talent showcase opportunity for young performers.

In 2018, Joe became the co-owner and Executive Director of **STEPS ON BROADWAY**, New York City's premiere professional training center. *Dance Teacher* magazine featured Joe as the cover story of their May 2019 issue. Joe also serves as the Executive Producer and Director of the *Chita Rivera Awards*, the only annual awards that exclusively recognize dance excellence on Broadway and film. For over a decade, Joe directed *The Fred & Adele Astaire Awards*. Joe's dynamic style and explosive choreography have established him as a driving force in the shaping of New York City jazz dance style. He has served on the faculty of many international arts centers - Mexico, Japan, Italy and Denmark. In New York City, Joe has been an established jazz teacher at Steps on Broadway for decades and served on the prestigious faculty of The Juilliard School for 27 years.



SUZITAYLOR is an internationally recognized masterteacher and choreographer and has been training professional and aspiring young dancers for the past 30 years. He appeared in Twyla Tharp's Broadway production Movin' Out, and had his singing debut in Burt Bacharach's and Hal David's The Look Of Love, choreographed by Ann Reinking and Scott Ellis.

Richardson has appeared on celebrated stages across the world, namely The Metropolitan Opera, The Kennedy Center, Paris Opera, The Bolshoi Theatre, The Mariinsky Theatre, The State Kremlin Palace, Teatro Massimo, and Teatro alla Scala. In the spring of 2109, Richardson received an honorary doctorate degree from The University of North Carolina School of the Arts in recognition of his extensive contributions to the field of dance.

Richardson has been a celebrity guest performer and choreographer for productions across media such as the American Music Awards, the Academy Awards, City Center's Encores! series, Italy's AMICI, and international franchises of So You Think You Can Dance. Richardson has been featured by famed artists such as Michael Jackson, Prince, Madonna, Elton John, and Aretha Franklin, and he appears in celebrated films such as the Oscar-Award winning Chicago, Julie Taymor's Across the Universe, and the recent independent film, Fall to Rise.
