



## Nursing Portfolio Requirements

Students may receive up to 22 credits in the form of a portfolio for experiences that have shown continuing education in the field of nursing. Students who have a minimum of 7 of the possible portfolio items and current BLS/CPR certification will earn the 22 credits towards the required 124 credits.

Each of the following items is equivalent to 3 credit hours. Students are allowed to receive credit for up to 7 items from below to obtain 21 credit hours. In addition, 1 credit hour will be given for current BLS/CPR certification to complete the required 22 credit hours. Students who do not have 7 items will make up the difference in elective courses. (Example: A student has 6 items would receive 18 credit hours and need to take 3 additional credit hours in electives.).

The following items are acceptable forms of portfolio experiences:

- 45 continuing education units (CEUs) from an accredited source in nursing\*
- Minimum 3 years of full-time RN employment  
To use this option, a letter from the place of employment must be submitted. The letter must include:
  - Workplace/Facility name
  - Start date of employment as an RN
  - End date of employment or to present
  - Your name
  - From supervisor, manager, Human Resources, etc.
- Nursing Skill Certifications\* (see below options)
- National Nursing Certifications\* (see below options)
- Prior courses taken that are not required by the associate's degree RN program where the degree was awarded; each 3 credit hours course will count as 1 item in the portfolio. To use this option, the student must provide the Program Specialist with a copy of the degree plan from the school where the associate's degree was awarded.

\*CEUs, nursing skill certifications, and national nursing certifications must be within the past 5 years.
