- 2. There are several choices for the framing construction on which the engineered stone must rest upon. After-market and pre-fabricated benches can be used, or a rigid structure can be created with the use of a suitable substrate and a waterproof membrane. Consult a certified contractor for local building codes.
- 3. A free floating bench installation cannot be used with this engineered stone.
- 4. Ensure that the top of the bench is sloped with a ¼" angle toward the front of the bench to allow proper drainage of liquid.
- 5. Maintain plastic covering to protect during installation.
- 6. Install the engineered stone bench top using a premium, unmodified thinset.
- 7. Important notes: waterproofing on the walls must be continuous from the wall, over the top of the bench sub-structure, and down over the face. The top of the bench must be sloped towards the drain. If using a wooden bench frame, waterproofing is required and must be tied into the floor and wall membranes.







Wall Tile Waterproofed Substrate Niche Back Panel Niche Sill Caulk Unmodified Thinset





Corner Shower Niche









NOTE: Installation of corner shower shelf should be done at time of tiling of bathtub wall tiles to ensure easy and correct installation.

- Clean the installation area with a neutral cleaner and lint free cloth.
 Cut the tile to allow the width of the corner shelf to fit. Ensure the shelf is sloped to allow water drainage. DO NOT USE DRY CUTTING
- METHODS. Wear a respirator when cutting, grinding, or polishing. Children should not be present during cutting, grinding, or polishing.
- 3. Apply unmodified thinset to the back edge of the shelf, pressing the shelf firmly into the notch while applying even pressure.
- 4. Use wedge spacers to fit the shelf flush to the upper tile border, and wait for thinset to cure as per the manufacturer's instructions before use.5. Apply silicone caulk to the top edges of the shelf to seal, using a water finger to smoothen out any excess caulk. 
