RUSSIA: ARTASH ANDRIASOV*



Born in 1986 to Armenian refugee parents, Artash moved across former Soviet Republics before settling in Russia. At 15, he became a Christian, studied the Bible, and preached while working as a tailor and DJ. He attended a preaching

school, later serving as pulpit minister in Rostov, where he inspired youth. The congregation now worships in their own building, seating 50 people.

GREECE: DINO & DEBBIE ROUSSOS*



Dino's faith began when his father became a Christian in 1963. Baptized at 17, Dino preached before earning bachelor's and master's degrees at ACU, where he met and married Debbie in 1977. Supported by

Prestoncrest since 1982, they've established Churches of Christ in Athens and Crete and hold worship services in several languages each Sunday.

CHAD: DJONGA FELTOING & ENOCH MBAIHODOUM*



Djonga Feltoing became a Christian in 1994. He was trained at the Biblical Training Center in Cotonou, Benin. After working for 6 years in Cameroon, Djonga returned to Chad in 2007 to start a mission in Moundou. Enoch Mbaihondoum joined the

efforts in 2013, and helps Djonga further the gospel. They evangelize using Bible correspondence courses and preaching on the radio to reach the lost.

CONGO: HILTON TERRY BIBLE SCHOOL*



The Hilton Terry Bible School opened in September 2004 to train French-speaking evangelists, teaching them to preach the gospel. The school offers a 3-year program for 15 students at a time. As of 2024, 128 students have graduated

and are involved in church growth across 9 provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, including Kinshasa, with 500+ members in 6 congregations.

MIDDLE EAST: KELISANET



Nathan, born in Iran, became a Christian in 2007. In 2008, he started discipling the first house church in Iran while using the internet to share the Gospel across the country. Arrested in 2011, he was jailed for 38 days before fleeing

Iran. Nathan and his wife Mahsa now plant house churches online from Turkey and the US, having established over 80 churches and baptized hundreds.

CONGO: KIKWIT CHURCHES*



The Church of Christ in Kikwit was established in 2020 by Elder Charma Wampie. Charma was introduced to the Church of Christ's teachings, and began proclaiming the gospel of salvation, contrasting with the prosperity teachings of the

other area churches. By 2023, 2,000 were worshiping in 10 new churches, with 4,000+ attending. Rural areas of the DRC are hearing and responding! All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before You. ~ Psalm 22:27

GUATEMALA: ADAN & MIRIAM BENAVENTE*



Adan and his wife, Miriam, live and work in Solola, Guatemala with their 5 children. Adan graduated from the Bible Institute in Tegucigalpa, Honduras and began his ministry in Quetzaltenango in 1987. Since moving to Solola

in 1998, they have planted a church as well as started two new congregations. Adan also helps teach and train new preachers through various institutes.

GUATEMALA: SIMEON & MARIBEL SAPON*



Simeon Sapon, born and raised in Antigua, earned his BS in Antigua and Theology in Honduras. He studied Administration in Guatemala City before moving back to Antigua to preach. In October 1996, he married Maribel and they

planted a church in Chimaltenango. Each year, Simeon coordinates outreach with local preaching students following Prestoncrest's summer mission trip.

GUATEMALA: WERNES & MARIA TOBAR*



Wernes Tobar was born and raised in El Salvador, attended BICA, and holds a BS in Science and Math. He served as a preacher in Ahuachapan (2008-10) and in Palmares, Costa Rica (2011-14) before moving to Guatemala. In 2015, he

became the senior minister at Antigua CoC, where he led significant growth and started community programs. Wernes and Maria have a daughter, Tiara.

GHANA MISSIONS: YENDI, SABOBA, & BEYOND*



Ghana Missions began in 2010 to partner with evangelists to spread the Gospel. By 2024, 3,400+ baptisms and 100+ congregations have emerged, with attendance nearing 6,000. Evangelists receive training through Heritage Christian

College. Prestoncrest provides oversight of the work in Saboba and partners with the Nsawam Road Church of Christ who provides oversight in Yendi.

AUSTRIA: BILL & MARIE-CLAIRE MCDONOUGH



Bill served 4 years in the US Air Force, worshiping with missionaries worldwide. After his service, he pursued missions, planting churches in Germany. He led medical teams to the Caribbean and launched humanitarian efforts

in Eastern Europe. Bill and his wife Marie-Claire planted churches in Cambodia and Burma. Now in Austria, they work with refugees who've turned to Christ.

PHILIPPINES: BIBLE STUDY CENTER



Barry and Sherry Murrell moved to Cebu City, Philippines, in 1980, raising four children while ministering to the local community and founding the Bible Study Center. Their daughters, Sara and Amy, now run the center with their

husbands, offering free Bible classes. Together, they also help lead the local Church of Christ, continuing the family's multi-generational mission work.

SPANISH CHURCHES: JAVIER & KARLA LEON



Javier León began the "Avanza Líder" ministry in 2019 to foster Biblical leadership in smaller (30-50 member) Hispanic CoCs that lack Elders and effective leadership processes. As of 2023, the ministry has worked with 18 congregations across

multiple countries, focusing on leadership development, coaching, church growth, and video lessons to provide 6 months of small group Bible study.

KENYA: MADE IN THE STREETS



The mission of MADE IN THE STREETS (MITS) in Nairobi, Kenya, is to love and equip children from the streets, meeting their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. Since 1995, MITS has served children by providing first aid, Bible study,

food, counseling, and friendship. Those ready to leave the streets can attend MITS boarding school for education, counseling, and learn more about Jesus.

MISSIONS SUPPORT: CLYDE & GWEN ANTWINE



Clyde holds his B.A. in Bible from ACU. He and his wife, Gwen, are veterans of the mission field in Europe, serving in Germany and Switzerland. Now retired from the mission field, Clyde works with the Helpers In Missions (H.I.M.) program

at Oklahoma Christian, recruiting and mentoring young adults for missions. They also encourage local churches in Germany and Switzerland annually.

UKRAINE: DENNIS ZOLOTARYOV



After graduating from the Ukrainian Bible Institute, Dennis Zolotaryov and his family relocated to Irpin, Ukraine to work with the Irpin Church of Christ. Due to the Russian invasion in 2022, Dennis' ministry has more recently

shifted to humanitarian aid and refugee support. His family has sought refuge in Croatia, while he remains in Ukraine to serve those in need.

RED RIVER FAMILY ENCAMPMENT



The Red River Family Encampment (RRFE) in Red River, NM is held annually the 4th Sunday in June. With over 1,500 attendees (including Prestoncrest members), this event features gospel preaching, Bible study, singing, and

fellowship amid stunning scenery. Executive Director Jerry Lawlis coordinates the event and ministers to small congregations across Northern New Mexico.

Prestoncrest's support of each good work is categorized as either OVERSIGHT – or – PARTIAL SUPPORT. Efforts for which Prestoncrest provides OVERSIGHT are noted with an asterisk* above.

SUNDAY MORNINGS prestoncrest.org/sermons


