

Since You Know 1 John 5 Small Group Plan

Many years ago, I took a long hard look at my ministry direction. I knew that I followed Jesus, but did pursue ministry as he did? Was my style of ministry like his? My conclusion changed how I view ministry to this day.

I knew that I could either:

- #1 Make a good impression with many people ... or
- #2 Make a permanent difference with a few people.

I chose number two because that is what I saw Jesus doing. I would rather surface leaders than attract followers. There is much less (if any) limelight in choice number two, as well as less temptation to seek it. And there is much more true legacy.

Since You Know ...

... Where You Came From (v. 19)

"We know that we are children of God"

• How does it change your sense of purpose and your definition of legacy to "know" that you came from God and are returning to God?

... Where You Are (v. 19)

"the whole world is under the control of the evil one."

- Why are most Americans unaware of the spiritual battle going on around us?
- How real is the battle to you? Explain.

... What To Think (v. 20)

"We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is true"

• Describe the new way of thinking – "understanding" - that Jesus brought?

... Who To Follow (v. 20)

"And we are in him who is true by being in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life."

• How is Jesus our connection to God — "in him ... in his Son" ?

... Remain True To Who You Are (v. 21)

"Dear children, keep yourselves from idols."

• What "idols" in our world compete with this new understanding?

USE IT / APPLY IT ...

• He gives us a new way of thinking ...
