THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE IS UNDER ATTACK IN THE STATES

The National Popular Vote interstate compact (NPV) is state legislation intended to nullify the Electoral College without amending the Constitution. It takes effect if passed in enough states that they control a majority of electoral votes (270 out of 538).

Seventeen states and DC have passed NPV, with a total of 209 electoral votes (as of April 2024). It has passed at least one chamber in seven other states and has been introduced in every state.
