



The Chisholm Trail Campus' Learning Lab program encourages and supports students needing additional assistance in order to meet grade level expectations and be successful overall. This program does not offer a separate curriculum.

The goal of this program is to review content and practice skills which will transfer to improved classroom performance, thus assisting students in becoming more self-confident as independent learners. Learning specialists use multi-sensory and creative methods to reinforce mastery of concepts taught.

## Level One — \$1,305 per year

Designed for students who struggle with time management, have weak foundational skills in a particular subject, or have had previous difficulty or limited success in the classroom.

- Meet with specialist 2 times per week
- Provide help with study and organizational skills
- Monitor grades
- Ongoing communication with teachers and parents

## Level Two — \$2,195 per year

Designed for students with either a medical diagnosis or an educational diagnostic evaluation that reveals a learning difference.

- Meet with specialist 2-3 times per week, plus occasional drop-in meetings
- All above services for Level One
- Test in the Learning Lab with support of the learning specialist
- Available for reteach and retest on lessons
- Varied support according to diagnostic accommodations (extended time on tests, etc.)
- Provide a liaison among teachers, parents, and administration on behalf of the student
