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The Lakeside Campus' Learning Lab program encourages and supports students needing additional assistance in order to meet grade level expectations and be successful overall. This program does not offer a separate curriculum.

The Learning Lab helps students academically while giving them the tools they need to build confidence and to succeed in their classes. Additionally, the program helps students understand how they learn best and teaches them the skills needed to problem solve, plan, and organize in school and in life.

## **Middle and High School Learning Lab—\$2,745 per year**

The Learning Lab on the Lakeside Campus is designed to encourage and support the struggling student diagnosed with a learning difference and/or Attention Deficit Disorder.

Students receive an elective credit in Reading for their Learning Lab class, and it takes the place of either a fine art, world language, or athletic class in their schedule. Specific schedule adjustments will be made under recommendation of the Guidance Department.

- Classes meet three times a week
- Students receive guided instruction in study skills
- Students complete study skills lessons
- Students receive individual and small group SCS curriculum support
- Students have an opportunity to work on homework assignments during their Learning Lab class
- Students can take tests in the Learning Lab



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
